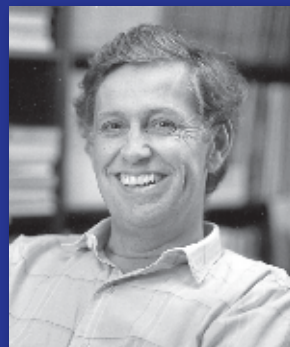
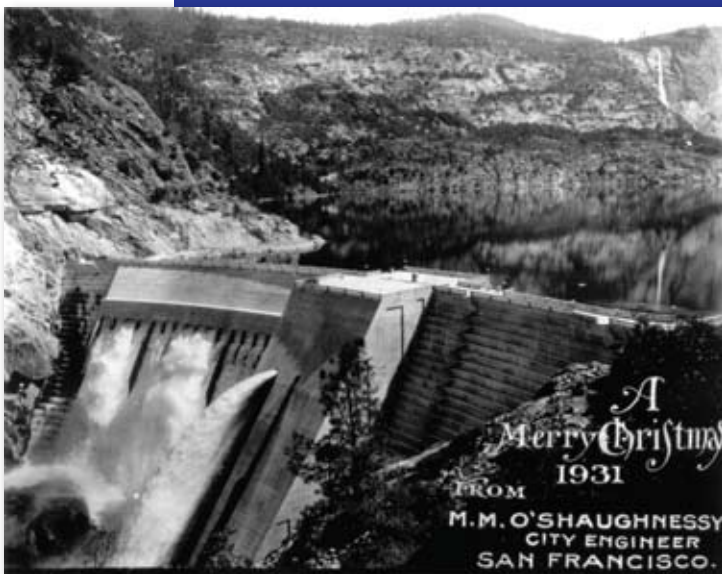

Because Hetch Hetchy Reservoir is within Yosemite National Park, it took an act of Congress for San Francisco to destroy a valley often called Yosemite's twin. John Muir described Hetch Hetchy Valley as "one of Nature's rarest and most precious mountain temples," while San Francisco cited the devastating fires following the 1906 earthquake as proof that this dam was desperately needed. Who was right? Come and hear arguments on both sides, so you can decide for yourself.
